A. DETAILS OF APPLICATION

This application is made under section 31A of Federal Court of Australia Act 1976 (Cth) and rule 26.01 of the Federal Court Rule 2011.

One the facts stated in the supporting affidavit, the applicant Lady Crown And On Behalf of Ngati Rangihou Corrangie Hapu dba Office of the Crown applies for the following relief:

- 1) The entirety of the court hearing, in the presence of Judge Jacqueline Gleeson, the respondent committed perjury on twelve (12) occasions by intentionally masquerading as the City of Parramatta trying to blind sight the Judge and the Applicant by attempting to pervert and obstruct the course of justice..
 - (a) the defence used by the respondent has no reasonable prospect of successfully defending the proceeding due to Perjury in the court, Misprision of Treason and masquerading as the City of Parramatta as their only rebuttal in the court.

- 2) Costs in favour of the respondent.
- 3) Seal and Enforce Final Orders dated 20th September 2019 filed on the Federal Court record on the 24th September 2019 that were agreed upon by the Ngyuddadunmardi Ariki Tribal Court and attested by Carol Major, Court Delegate /Justice of the Peace (Magistrate) 94318 and Krisandra Tweedie, Court Delegate /Justice of the Peace (Qualified) 95350
- 4) Such further orders as the Court deems fit without excluding, deleting or amending any part whatsoever of the Final Orders dated 20th September 2019 that were agreed upon by the Ngyuddadunmardi Ariki Tribal Court and attested by Carol Major, Court Delegate /Justice of the Peace (Magistrate) 94318 and Krisandra Tweedie, Court Delegate /Justice of the Peace (Qualified) 95350


